

Centrifuge Quote Worksheet

In order to expedite your request for a quote or purchase of a centrifuge you will need to have answers to the following questions before calling!

What relative centrifugal force (rcf) do I need the centrifuge to achieve?

Relative centrifugal force is the measurement of the force applied to a sample within a centrifuge. The test you are required to run will have this information.

What size tubes do I need to process?

Centrifuges will spin many different tube sizes, which require different adapters. This info is needed to provide you the correct adapters.

How many tubes do I need to spin at one time?

This will have a direct impact on the size of centrifuge you need!

Do I need a fixed angle rotor or horizontal rotor?

The test you are required to run may specify. Otherwise it is a preference.

Do I need a benchtop or floor model centrifuge?

While benchtop centrifuges are the most popular, floor models can save your counter space. Kneewell centrifuges are designed to roll into a knee space of a counter, which can be very useful.

Do I want more than the standard 90-day warranty?

We provide a 90-day, parts-only warranty for our advertised prices. We can provide up to a 1-year warranty and include on site service upon request.

Do I need on site service included in my warranty?

The standard 90-day warranty does not include on site service. If this is a requirement for your purchase we can provide this. The price of the centrifuge will be affected.

Do I need a lift gate on the delivery truck?

If your facility has a loading dock you will not need a lift gate. If you do not request a lift gate and the driver has to help you hand unload additional charges will be billed. Centrifuges which weigh in excess of 80lbs will be delivered via freight. The customer is responsible for getting the centrifuge from the delivery truck to its final location.
